Laughter may be good for your heart. A new study demonstrates that laughing causes the tissue that forms the inner lining of blood vessels, or the endothelium, to expand and increase blood flow – exactly what aerobic exercise does. In a study, 20 volunteers watched a 15-minute segment from a comedy movie, Kingpin, and then 48 hours later viewed the opening battle scene from Saving Private Ryan, the 1998 movie starring Tom Hanks. After each movie was shown, researchers used ultrasound to measure changes in blood vessel reactivity. On average, blood flow increased 22 percent after the Harrelson movie, comparable to the increase brought on by aerobic exercise, and decreased 35 percent after Saving Private Ryan. While a comedy can be good for people, a stress-inducing movie can have a negative effect on cardiac health, said Michael Miller, the lead author of the study. There is great variability among people," Miller said, "but anything that evokes an emotional response has an impact on the heart," and the impact can be negative as well as positive.
